Early proof point: WERT is already making complex frailty work easier to coordinate, not just creating another meeting.

1. What WERT is

Virtual MDT launched 1 June 2026

- Mon, Wed and Fri, up to one hour
- 4 Wisbech PCN practices represented
- CPFT, adult social care and VCSE partners already attending
- QEH involvement in complex discharge is the next step

It gives practices and partners a consistent route for escalation, follow-up and shared ownership.

3. Benefits being seen

For patients

Earlier escalation • joined-up input • clearer ownership • review for complex cases over time

Illustrative case themes

Falls and no local family support
Unsafe discharge / complex home situation
Self-neglect, cognition and wider social risk

For teams: less duplication, faster access to the right people, and more confidence vulnerable patients are not falling through gaps.

How we will evidence value next

Keep tracker simple: action owner, review date, completion and closure • Monthly participant pulse survey • 1–2 anonymised case examples each month • Add ED, admissions, readmissions and urgent GP contacts after 3–6 months
